RECRUITMENT DETAILS	<p>We are looking for art works and projects that utilize resources rooted in the region, such as Sado Island's nature, history, culture, climate, and scenery (World Heritage Site: Sado Island Gold Mine, Globally Important Agricultural Heritage Site: Sado's village-vicinity mountain Coexistence with Japanese Crested Ibises, Geopark and food, traditional performing arts and traditional architecture, Noh stage complex, etc.), and shed light on diverse values.</p> <p>Artwork proposal</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Installation Art: Artworks or display to be displayed during the festival 2. Performing Art: Music, dance, or theater play to be performed during the festival 3. Free Genre: Not limited to art, but peans/projects that encompass various fields (i.e. cooking, fashion, design, handicraft, technology etc. <p>※ Applicants can submit up to 3 proposes</p>
SITE FOR ARTWORK / PROJECT	<p>Across entire Sado City (i.e. Ryotsu area, Ogi area, Aikawa area) (i.e. Shopping streets, beach, rice fields, forests, lakes (Lake Kamo), houses, shrines, roads, etc.)</p> <p>*The specific locations for installation and activities will be determined by the secretariat according to the proposed plan.</p>
ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLICATION	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Individuals who understand the purpose of the Sado Island Galaxy Art Festival. 2. Those who agree to the terms of this call for proposals and can deeply engage with Sado Island, the festival venue, as well as its various communities. 3. Depending on the proposal, applicants must be able to stay on-site for a certain period and collaborate with residents on planning and production. <p>※ Depending on the proposed project, participants may be required to stay on-site and carry out programs or activities during the festival period.</p>
SELECTED PROJECTS / BUDGET	<p>Approximately 5-10 works of art will be selected (subject to change depending on the situation)</p> <p>Selected project will be financially supported up to JPY 500,000.</p> <p>※ The actual amount of support will be decided based upon the proposed estimate.</p> <p>※ The work production and installation costs include all costs required for production, such as transportation and accommodation costs.</p> <p>※ The final handling of profitable works will be decided in consultation with the executive committee.</p> <p>※ Some parts of the venue are designated as Special Zones of a World Heritage Site or as Sado-Yahiko-Yoneyama Quasi-National Park. Due to landscape conservation regulations and the Natural Parks Act, you may be asked to modify the proposed location or details of your artwork plan.</p>

Documents that will be useful for the plan, such as resume and examples of reference artwork <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Portfolio (includes past works / projects) * The image should help articulate your project. Please use a drawing, model, photo and/or diagram as seen appropriate. * Concept and summary of the proposed project should be clear and brief, either in Japanese or English and within 400 characters or 200 words respectively) 3. Application fee's receipt of payment *Attach the completion of bank transfer page if paying via net banking *Attach the notification of payment email if paying via credit card
REGULATIONS / CONDITIONS	Number of applications: Up to 3 plans per applicant. Conditions for the work itself: There are no requirements regarding size, material, weight, etc. *A plan that does not put a burden on the environment is preferable. Conditions for the installation environment: In principle, the plant must be able to be restored to its original state. If the plant has the necessary functions, those functions must be maintained. Conditions regarding installation period: In principle, the exhibit must be maintained in good condition throughout the duration of the art festival. (This does not apply to events and performances.) An implementation system will be established that will enable applicants to install and operate the equipment during the festival.
DEADLINE	Submit the proposal between March 31(Monday) and April 30 (Wednesday), 2025. 23:59 Japan Standard Time (UTC+9) Hand delivery, email and post mail of the proposal will not be accepted.
SELECTION PROCEDURE	First phase: Application screening Second phase: Interview This will be implemented sequentially for those who pass the first screening. *The results of the first phase will be notified directly by the secretariat only to those who pass the first phase. *Please note that the project office will not respond to any inquiries regarding the results of the selection procedure.
ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE RESULT	Successful proposals will be announced on the official website around early May of 2025 *It will not be disclosed whether the participating artists listed on the official website are the artists selected through public applications. *Please note that the project office will not respond to any inquiries regarding the results of the selection procedure.
